

WHAT TO DO IN THE EVENT OF A SAFEGUARDING INCIDENT

Reason to suspect a child, young person or vulnerable adult has been abused

Contact one of the Designated Safeguarding Officers immediately to deal with the incident & record what has happened on an IOM Sport Safeguarding Incident form
